The Imperial label is apropos for the porcelain vase because this piece is made of clay sourced from the area surrounding the kilns that produced objects for the Imperial estate during the heyday of the dynasties. The formulas to achieve the particular black on this vessel's surface is a secret one guarded by ceramicist families devoted to the single colour. The glossy depth achieved was originally produced exclusively for those in high society.
